For you, we have lined up Barbaresco, Barolo, Amarone della Valpolicella, Chianti Classico Riserva Gran Selezione, Brunello, Vino Nobile di Montalcini, Super Tuscan and Vin Santo.

WINE OF THE MONTH

FATTORIA POMONA

Chianti Classico Docg 2017 \$76

Fattoria Pomona is a small estate located in Castellina in Chianti, Tuscany. The owner of the estate is Ms. Monica Raspi. She is extremely passionate about wine. The vineyards are located at 1148 feet above sea level on calcareous soil. The estate was founded in 1890 by the great grandfather of Monica, who had originally intended for it to be a grain farm.

In 1982, the farm fell into the hands of Monica’s parents, who restored 2 vineyards on the property and began producing wine in limited quantities for local consumption. In 2007, the turning point for the winery was when Monica decided to close her veterinary clinic and focus on upholding the family winemaking tradition of the estate.

This wine is made from 95% Sangiovese and 5% Colorino. Fermented in stainless steel, aged for 12 months in Slavonian oak plus 3 months in bottle before release.

Certified organic since 2012.

CARL'S DESCRIPTORS

Opens with rich notes of cherries, red flowers, tomato paste, and dried herbs on the back of the nose with hints of licorice, tobacco and sweet spices. On the palate, this wine is well structured with medium plus tannins and bright balanced acidity.
